Blood Borne Pathogen - Post Exposure

Prevention is the best method to decrease your risk of a blood borne pathogen (BBP) exposure. Please know where to locate and how to utilize personal protective equipment. If there is any risk of spray or spatter, use facemasks/eye protection.

In the event you do become exposed to a BBP or question whether you have, please follow these steps.

- 1. Start initial first aide, wash the wound or flush eyes or mucous membranes. Eyewash stations are not necessary to begin the initial wash/flush the exposed area.
- Contact Employee Health Services (EHS) at 255-5634 between the hours of 7:00am-4:30pm, Monday-Friday. If outside of these hours, please contact the Administrative Nursing Supervisor on duty so you can receive appropriate follow-up.
- Fill out an "RL solutions report". Your health and safety are important. Protect yourself and, if an exposure does occur, begin immediate first aide and obtain the appropriate follow-up care as soon as possible. Contact EHS if you haven't already to receive a post exposure consultation.

The Annual First Choice PTO Process will open up to staff on Tuesday, September 2, 2014 and will run through Sunday, October 26th. Each skill level will be divided into tiers by seniority and will be given a specific timeframe for submitting their requests. You can expect to receive communication from your Scheduling Associate on or before Friday, August 29th, which will contain all the details you need on how to submit your First Choice and Alternate PTO requests.

At the far left hand corner under All Entities click on the triangle and select St. Cloud Hospital (the bottom of the list), then click on Patient Care. Select "S" from the index listed at the top of the page to access the Staffing/Scheduling: PTO, Scheduled and Unscheduled, Guidelines for Patient Care Areas.
